RADIO CONTROL FLYING RULES

No spectators beyond this point.

A.M.A. B.C.F. or H.A.M.C.I. badge must be displayed beyond this point.

Radio controlled flying only.

A.M.A. or equivalent insurance required.

A.M.A. safety codes and field flying enforced.

- Aircraft flying is allowed only in designated flight areas.
 All takeoffs will be followed by a turn into designated flight area.
 All flying will conform to standard flight pattern rules.
 S. Barker Cypress is immediately behind the tree line to the east of the field line speed aircraft.
- 4. S. Barker Cypress is immediately behind the tree line to the east of the field. High speed aircraft should take precaution to avoid overflight when making left turns beyond the end of runway from a southeasterly heading.
- There is no frequency control at this facility.
 Non 24 GHZ transmitter users should self-assure that no interfering frequencies are in use on the field
- 6. Maximum time at a flying station is 20 minutes if there are other pilots waiting for a station.
- Beginners must be under direct supervision of experienced pilot until competency is demonstrated.
- Engine or electric motor running only at and beyond the pit area.
- 9. No more than five models flying at any time.
- 10. All ham frequency users must be F.C.C. licensed.
- 11. Mufflers as specified by AMA regulations required.
- 12. All pilots must fly from the flight stations.
- 13. All radio equipment must be narrow band except for ham band frequencies.
